Grant Application Criteria Include:

- * Educational program
- * Number of fellows per year
- * Faculty expertise
- * Research/publications and presentations
- * Educational resources
- * Anticipated outcomes of grant funding
- * Program accreditation status
- * Other sources of funding for program

Residency Grants up to \$5,000 available. Orthopaedic residencies / general education including, but not limited to:

- * Books and journals for program use

- * Educational courses, including online courses, self-assessment courses and other learning aids
- * Journal club support
- * Development of novel curricula and/or educational resources
- * Skills Lab and cadaver sessions
- * Visiting professors / Grand Rounds speakers

Applications with a broader benefit to the residency program are given special consideration.
