This program supports entry-level faculty to integrate geriatrics with novel basic, clinical, or health services diabetes research. This award supports pilot and feasibility studies that may lack preliminary data, but offer considerable promise for the cure, prevention, or treatment of diabetes in an aging population.

Support: Awards are a maximum of \$75,000 per year for up to two years. No indirect costs may be requested.

Deadline Dates: January 15, 2010 for July 1, 2010 funding and July 15, 2010 for January 1, 2011 funding.
