Neurosurgical residents/ fellows/ junior faculty are eligible to submit proposals (\$500). Only junior faculty are eligible for the Fellowship Award (\$50,000). The objective of this Fellowship is to foster the spirit of team-building necessary for executing multi-center studies, which are critically needed in neurosurgery in general, and spinal surgery in particular.

The objective of this award is to create an infrastructure necessary for executing well-designed multi-center studies, to promote the advancement of evidence-based neurosurgical practices, with an emphasis on spine.
