Request for Proposals: American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine Research Grants Program

AACOM's 2012 Grants Program includes awards for medical education research and institutional research. Institutional research is a broad category of work done at colleges (and across colleges within a profession) to inform decision-making and planning. Topics related to workforce issues—such as the implications of the expansion of osteopathic medical colleges, branch campuses, additional teaching sites, and class sizes—are of increasing interest.

A recent generous grant from the Osteopathic Heritage Foundation has allowed AACOM to increase its grant offerings. Researchers are invited to request up to \$10,000 for collaborative research projects. Researchers may still seek funding of up to \$5,000 for single campus research or smaller collaborative studies.

Eligibility

Applicants must be educators at Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine, including their OPTI programs.

2012 Deadlines

Proposals due: February 24, 2012

Notification of outcome: March 19, 2012

Note: Each grant will be for a period of 18 months and will not be renewable. Quarterly financial statements and a final project summary must be submitted to AACOM at the end of the grant period
