American Association of Endodontists Grant to Educators for Annual Session

This grant acknowledges the critical role educators play in strengthening the specialty. Full-time educators receive reimbursement for one-half the Annual Session registration fee and \$500 for travel. Full-time educators who present during a track at the Annual Session will receive reimbursement for the total cost of registration.

March 1

THE GRANT

Recipients will be reimbursed for one-half the Annual Session registration fee and \$500 for travel expenses. Full-time educators who present during a track at the Annual Session will receive reimbursement for the total cost of registration. Applicants will receive confirmation of their eligibility one month prior to annual session. Reimbursement will occur no later than 60 days following the close of the meeting.

ELIGIBILITY

Full-time educators who meet the criteria listed below are eligible.

The applicant must be a full-time educator as defined by their respective institution.

1. Applicants must be involved in predoctoral and/or postdoctoral teaching (graduate endodontic programs/GPR programs/AEGD programs).
2. Applicants may be general dentists, researchers or endodontists, but must be members of the AAE. Nonmembers must file a membership application by February 15.
3. Applicants must be teaching in accredited U.S. or Canadian dental schools or medical schools/centers.
4. Applicants must participate in one of the following activities:
 - a. A presentation;
 - b. An oral or poster research presentation, or a table clinic;
 - c. A committee meeting; or
 - d. Mentor a student presentation such as a table clinic.

Along with the application form, the applicant must provide a letter from the institution's dean or administrative head confirming:

1. The school's criteria for classification as a full-time faculty member; and
2. The individual's status as a full-time faculty member.
