Amount: Up to \$50,000/year

Application Deadline: March 1st

Review/Notification Date: Summer/Fall

Eligibility Requirements:

• The applicant must be pursuing a career in colorectal surgery

For citizens of USA or Canada:

• The applicant must be currently enlisted in or a graduate of an accredited residency program in either general or colon and rectal surgery or be a recent graduate of a program approved by the Research Foundation of ASCRS

• The applicant must be sponsored by a colon and rectal program director or ASCRS Fellow

• ASCRS member must be co-principal investigator or principal investigator

For foreigners traveling to USA or Canada:

• The applicant must be sponsored by a clinician investigator who is an ASCRS member and board certified by the ABCRS with a research program

• ASCRS member must be co-principal investigator or principal investigator
