International Society for Eye Research Travel Fellowships

The ISER Travel Fellowship program is funded through a variety of sources to support the participation of young scientists at each Biennial meeting of the International Society for Eye Research. The ISER Membership Committee reviews and ranks applications, and selects the final travel fellowship recipients, based on established criteria.

ISER anticipates awarding a varying number of Travel Fellowships to graduate students, post-doctoral fellows or young faculty within five years of formal training (<http://www.iser.org/bylaws.pdf>) to subsidize meeting expenses. The awards will provide substantial, but not complete, coverage of expenses related to: air travel, meeting registration and room (double occupancy) for the days of the meeting.

ISER holds a Biennial Meeting bringing together leading scientists, both basic and clinical, from all around the world to share their latest research. The meeting has a strong international flavor and by virtue of its different venues has played a major role in promoting the communication of research between local, national and international organizations. The next Biennial Meeting will be held in Berlin, Germany, July 21 - 25, 2012.
