Application deadline is March 15, 2012.

Grant: Up to US\$15,000

The IASP Collaborative Research Grants support international, interdisciplinary collaborations in pain research.

Eligibility Requirements:

The principal investigator in charge of the overall project must be a member of IASP of at least one year's standing.

Three grants are available per year.

The grants cover travel and accommodation costs to support collaborative research by two or more research groups located in different countries.

The IASP Committee on Research will evaluate all proposals according to:

- a) scientific merit;
- b) the qualifications of the investigators;
- c) evidence of interdisciplinary collaboration.

Collaborations between basic science and clinical research groups will receive priority.

IASP sponsorship will be in the form of a personal grant to the principal investigator of the project, who is responsible for managing funds and must submit a detailed financial and scientific report within two years.

Publications arising from work supported by these grants must acknowledge the source of funding.

How to Apply:

(All applications must be submitted in English and as a singled PDF file.)

Include with your application form:

A description of the research project.

The curriculum vitae of the principal investigator from each collaborating institution.

Evidence that the costs of the research itself are covered with other funds.
