****Note:** Student Scholar Grant applicants cannot save applications in progress. Applications must be completed in one sitting. Please have all materials and information available before starting an application.

The purpose of the ASN Student Scholar Grant is to enable selected medical students with an interest in either basic or clinical research to spend 10-52 weeks engaged in continuous full-time research in a nephrology lab. The student must work with a mentor that is an active ASN member.

Eligibility

To apply for an ASN Student Scholar Grant, a candidate:

Must perform full-time research in a nephrology lab with a mentor that is an active ASN member.

Must be enrolled at a US or Canadian medical school in good standing.

Cannot already have other sources of stipend support.

Applicants who are uncertain of his/her eligibility should request an advisory opinion from ASN before completing an application.

Program

ASN Student Scholar Grant recipients complete full-time research with an active ASN member in a nephrology lab. The project period can be a summer, semester, academic year, or any other 10-52 week period of continuous full-time research. A progress report is required at the end of research period.

Use of Grant Funds

ASN Student Scholar grant funds can be used for:

Salary: \$400 per week.

Supplies and lab expenses: \$100 per week

Travel: Up to \$1,500 will be reimbursed for travel-related expenses to attend the ASN Annual Meeting at Kidney Week.

Evaluation and Conditions of Appointment Selection

ASN Student Scholar Grants are to applicants who show exceptional ability and promise for a research career. The evaluation of an application will be based on the applicant's general qualifications, prior training, independence, and promise for productivity. Attention will be given to the quality and originality of the applicant's previous research and the scientific merit of the research proposed in the application.

After an award has been made, a change of sponsoring institution or primary mentor or a major change in the research plan requires prior approval for continuation of the grant. Students are expected to conduct research according to the highest scientific and ethical standards and in compliance with all applicable laws, regulations, and policies regarding protection of human research subjects, humane care and use of laboratory animals, and laboratory safety.

Application

Applicants for the ASN Student Scholar Grant must submit the following materials:

Project proposal (no longer than 6 pages).

CV or resume.

Mentor reference letter.

External reference letter.

Only online applications will be accepted. Once started, the application cannot be saved. Applicants should have materials ready before starting an application.
